

## NH Violence Against Women Campus Consortium Logo Contest

### Introduction

This document describes the official rules (“Official Rules”) of the New Hampshire Violence Against Women Campus Consortium logo contest organized by the New Hampshire Violence Against Women Campus Consortium (“NHVAWCC”), (the “Contest”). The object of this contest is to design a logo for the NHVAWCC. The NHVAWCC is a group of campus and community professionals who share a common concern about sexual violence, relationship violence, and stalking on NH college campuses. Group members represent public and private institutions of higher education as well as community organizations focused on ending these types of violence and providing services to those affected. Information on how to enter and about the prizes is part of these Official Rules. To the extent of any inconsistency, these Official Rules prevail.

### Definitions

“Entry” means a logo design created by the Entrant for this Contest.

“Entrant” means the individual that offers the Entry under the terms of this Contest.

### Eligibility

1. The Contest is open to individuals aged 18 years or older, companies, educational institutions, organizations, etc. or to groups associated with such institutions.
2. Contest judges and their immediate family are not eligible to enter the Contest.
3. Entrants must be of sufficient legal age and standing to enter into a contract with NHVAWCC as required below.

### How to Enter

1. Initial entries must be submitted by email to [nhvawcclogocontest@gmail.com](mailto:nhvawcclogocontest@gmail.com). The entries must be submitted as a scalable vector graphic in EPS format, and also as a JPG. See the Submission Guidelines below for further information.
2. The email must include the name, age, postal address, phone number and email address of the Entrant and be accompanied by the Entry Form.
3. No more than 3 Entries may be submitted by any one Entrant.
4. Entries must conform to the Submission Guidelines set out below. Entries which fail to do so will be rejected.
5. The deadline for Entries is 11:59pm on March 2, 2018, Eastern Standard Time.
6. We will attempt to acknowledge all entries within one week of receipt; however, we cannot be responsible for entries or responses lost in e-mail.

7. There is no fee to enter the Contest.

### Submission Guidelines

The purpose of the contest is to design a logo for the NHVAWCC. The logo will be used promotional and official forms, online and in print. Flexibility is a key requirement, including the need to resize easily and to look good in black and white as well as color. The final version of the logo will need to be suitable for high quality printing, while also looking good at relatively small sizes.

Entrants should take care to ensure that their Entries are not in any way similar to existing logos or other copyrighted images.

There are no specific design elements the logo must include, however, the NHVAWCC will need to be able to add the group name with the logo for some uses.

Therefore, Entrants may want to consider how the group might incorporate its name with the Entry, and the aesthetics once this text is added.

The logo must not contain any text other than “NH” or “New Hampshire.” Inclusion of “NH” or “New Hampshire” is not a requirement.

JPGs 1000 pixels square of the logo are also requested so that entries can be posted to NHVAWCC web sites without the need for conversion.

The limit on attachment sizes for email is 50MB. If your submission exceeds this size, even after compression, please send the images individually and note clearly in your emails that you are doing so.

### Prizes

Subject to the legal requirements outlined above, the winning design will be announced on the NHVAWCC website, social media account, and with an email to the winner.

The winning Entrant will receive:

1. A \$250 prize. The winning Entrant is responsible for any tax.
2. The right to use the basic logo for the purpose of identifying as the designer of the logo.

### Judging and Selection of Winner

1. Entries will be reviewed by the subcommittee and narrowed down to a list of top selections; final votes will be completed by members of the NHVAWCC. Their decision will be final. No further correspondence shall be entered into.
2. NHVAWCC reserves the right not to select a winner if, in its sole discretion, no suitable entries are received.
3. NHVAWCC reserves the right to disqualify any Entrant or Entry at its sole discretion. No correspondence shall be entered into.
4. Accepting the prize constitutes permission for NHVAWCC to make public and otherwise use winner’s name. Further personal data may be requested but is not required.
5. No timetable is set for the announcement of a winner.

6. There will also be a referral prize, for which only individuals will be eligible.
7. All the individuals named on the entry forms as “person who referred artist to contest” will be entered into a raffle, with one raffle ticket per entry

that names the individual. The winner will be selected at random. The prize for referral raffle will be \$50. The winner or the referral prize will be responsible for any taxes.

#### Intellectual Property

1. All submitted work must be original and not based on any pre-existing design.
2. All Entries will become the sole property of NHVAWCC. NHVAWCC shall have unlimited rights to use and display the submitted work in any manner it deems appropriate.
3. Participants agree that by entering this contest, they are assigning any and all title, rights, and interest in the submitted work to NHVAWCC.

#### Acceptance

Participation constitutes the Entrant’s full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules. By participating in the Contest, the Entrant is representing and warranting that the Entrant has read and understood, and agrees to be bound by, these rules. Including the guides and rules referred to herein, these Official Rules constitute the entire agreement between the Entrant and NHVAWCC in relation to the Contest. They govern the Entrant’s participation and supersede any prior or other agreements between the Entrant and NHVAWCC and relating to the Contest.
